USING YOUR VOICE MAIL \*\*Please note that if you are in a room where voice mail is currently set up for another teacher you will need to follow the directions under Creating/Changing Your Name that Callers Hear

#### Instructions for Initializing a New Voice Mailbox

- Call voice mail by dialing 111
- Enter your extension number and press #
- When prompted for a password press # (or try 2 4 6 8 if it is not a new mailbox)
- Press 1 to record your first and last name. (Note: this step is not recording a personal greeting.) after recording your name, press 1. Press # to approve or 1 to rerecord.
- Password must now be at least 3 digits (maximum 8 digits). Enter a new password and press #. Re-enter your new password and press #. When these two entries match, voice mail will say "changed", give the status of a new message and prompt you to select an activity from the main menu.

#### Creating a Personal Greeting for Callers to Hear

- · Call voice mail by dialing 111
- Enter your extension number and press #
- Enter your password (as setup in the above instructions).
- At the main activity menu, press 3 1 2 1 (you can listen to the instructions after each number) and record a personal greeting. When finished recording, press 1 2 3 to review, \* D (\* 3) to delete and record, or # to approve.
- Press 1 to activate the personal greeting (this overrides the system greeting). Press # to return to the activity menu.

## **Creating/Changing Your Name that Callers Hear**

- Call voice mail by dialing 111
  enter your extension number and #
  enter your password
- At the main activity menu, press 5
- At the next menu press 5 again
- The system will tell you when to speak your name
- Press 1, when finished recording your name
- You will then be prompted to approve your name, delete your name or rerecord your name

### **Changing Your Password**

- Call voice mail by dialing 111
  enter your extension number and #
  enter your password
- At the main activity menu, press 5
- At the next menu press 4, to change your password
- Enter your new password and the # sign
- Re-enter your new password and the # sign

# **Retrieving & Deleting Voice Mail Messages**

- · Call voice mail by dialing 111
- Enter your extension number and press #
- Enter your password (as setup in the above instructions)
- · To get messages press 2
- To listen to the message press 0
- To **delete** the message after listening to it press star "\*" then "D" (the number 3)
